Starbucks Must Respect the Right of Workers to Join a Union!

Starbucks workers have improved their work life in the face of a relentless anti-union campaign. Starbucks has flouted the law with impunity as it tramples on workers' rights:

- The company has terminated four IWW baristas- Joe Agins, Jr., Charles Fostrom, Daniel Gross, and Evan Winterscheidt in retaliation for their union activity.
- Legal charges from the IWW resulted in a massive Labor Board complaint against the company. To settle the complaint, the company agreed to refrain from interrogating, bribing, coercing, and discriminating against IWW members.
- The settlement agreement also struck down Starbucks' national policy prohibiting union pins and sharing written union information on company property in addition to reinstating two IWW members who had been discharged for union activity.

Shamefully, even after the settlement agreement Starbucks continues to break the law and refuses to respect the right of baristas to join a union.

The Starbucks Coffee Co. is an anti-worker anti-union corporation that does not deserve your hard-earned money. Please shop elsewhere until all of the fired IWW baristas are reinstated.
